

Extract from the Proceedings of the Council of Education, dated the 27<sup>th</sup> December 1845.

A. III Read Letter from the Secretary Hindoo College N<sup>o</sup> 125 dated 13<sup>th</sup> December, Submitting for consideration and orders, the application of Doorgadoss Chowdry and Purooram Boorooa for admission as pay Students.

Ordered, that Doorgadoss Chowdry be admitted for the reasons mentioned in his petition as his qualifications are known to fit him for such an indulgence. Likewise that Purooram Boorooa be readmitted, as he bears a good character, - was on the eve of promotion to a higher class, when his friends removed him from the college - and coming from the distant province of Assam, is considered deserving of some degree of consideration being extended to him.

A. IV Read Letter from the same N<sup>o</sup> 120 dated 13<sup>th</sup> Dec. Submitting information and suggestion as to the mode of collection of Schooling bills at the Hindoo College - and states that the Managers are favorable for instituting the practice of each boy or his friend bringing the Schooling in advance to the College.

Ordered, That the Suggestions of the Management be adopted, and carried into effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> of March 1846. the Secretary making

such

such Subsidiary arrangements, as will cause the  
change to be effected with the least possible in-  
convenience to the Institution. - that the Establi-  
-ment of Collecting Sircars be reduced from the  
1<sup>st</sup> of March, and all per Centage upon the  
collections cease from that date.
