Extract from a letter from the Secretary to the Government of India in
the Financial Department to the Address of the Secretary to the Govern-
ment of Bombay dated 22^d February 1845.

Viewing the matter in this light it will be necessary
in conformity with Paragraph 2^d of the dispatch to include in
the return all unencovenanted Servants, European, and East Indian,
as contradistinguished from Natives of India, and as regards the
latter, to limit the detail to Sudder Amcens, Moonsiffs, Deputy A
Collectors, and other Officers, of Superior grade, Omitting entirely
mere Subordinate ministerial Officers, such as Treasurers Clerks &c.
who exercise no control whatever over the Establishments in which
they are employed.
