I venture to make very special recommendations for promoting Babu Aboni Kishor Datta Roy, B.Sc., B.T., B.L., Assistant Master, Hare School, now drawing Rs 145/ per month, to the post of an Assistant Headmaster, for the work done by him in connexion with the Bengal Education Week. He was entrusted with the task of receiving innumerable (about ten thousand, I guess) exhibits sent by about 400 schools, classifying them according to subjects, and then distributing them over the different rooms of the Hare School and the Baker Laboratory, under the direction of Mr A. N. Basu, Secretary of the Exhibits Committee, and finally collecting and making them over to the owners.

His work was characterised by precision, thoroughness and ability. Not a bit of paper is missing from his file, and I also believe that all the articles have been made over to the owners.

I will not say much about the tremendous physical labour involved in the task because all who took a prominent share in the task of organising the exhibition and making it a success had to work very hard.
