In this connexion I have to add that for administrative reasons it is not possible to transfer Babu Abani Ranjan Sen Gupta, Assistant Head Master, Hooghly Branch School, to the Hindu School.

Sir,

With reference to your No. 3883 A (Con.) dated the 26th April 1930 regarding the question of transferring Babu Charu Chandra Das Gupta, Assistant Head Master, Barrackpore, to the Hindu School, I have the honour to say that I have consulted the Head Master and find that he is very unwilling to accept Charu Babu as his assistant.

2. It appears that Charu Babu was a Head Master for nearly 4 years and was then reduced to the rank of Assistant Head Master. Presumably, therefore, his record ~~is~~ unsatisfactory.

3. The Head Master of the Hindu School who knows him personally, has not a high opinion of him and he is anxious that when Babu Mohini Mohan Das is transferred, he should be succeeded by Babu Abani Ranjan Sen Gupta, at present Assistant Head Master of the Hooghly Branch School, whom he has known intimately for 8 years and whom he regards as likely to be of the greatest assistance at a troublesome time.

4. I myself do not know either of the persons mentioned, but I think it very undesirable that the Head Master of so important a school as the Hindu School should be given an Assistant Head Master, in whom he has no confidence, and I attach considerable importance to the fact that Charu Babu has actually been reduced from the rank of Head Master.

 - (c) Assistant Head Master, Hare School from 14th April 1924 to 23rd September 1924.

- (d) Assistant Head Master, Hindu School from 24th September 1924 to 17th June 1925.
- (e) Head Master, Hindu School (Offg:) from 18th June 1925 to 28th July 1925.
- (f) Head Master, Rangpur Zilla School from 3rd August 1925 to 5th May 1929.
- (g) Assistant Head Master, Barrackpur Government High School from 14th May 1929 up till now.
- (h) Subjects taught by him - English and Mathematics.

2. The post of Assistant Head Master, Hindu School is likely to fall vacant in July 1930 consequent on the transfer, on promotion of its present incumbent, Babu Mohini Mohan Das. I have to enquire whether you have any objection to the appointment of Babu Charu Chandra Das Gupta to this vacancy.
