Memorandum.

Calcutta, the 23rd November 1935.

The undersigned is directed to inform the Education Department of this Government that the Agent to the Governor-General, Punjab States, has taken exception to the case of an individual state within his Agency addressing authorities in Bengal, direct without observing the proper channel of correspondence through the Agent to the Governor-General. He has pointed out that this causes inevitable confusion and has requested that every Department of this Government might be informed that any state in the Punjab States Agency making a direct reference to them should be referred to the proper channel of communication. The officers subordinate to the Education Department should also be informed accordingly. The District Officers and Commissioners of Divisions have been informed direct.


