With reference to ~~the~~ your Memo No. 6501 A dated the 2nd August 1934 communicating the appointment of Babu Manindra Nath Mitra as Demonstrator in Physics, Krishnagar College, I have the honour to recommend Babu Narendra Nath Sen, Assistant in the Physics Department, to the vacancy in the Subordinate Educational Service (Rs 125- 350/- new scale) As I have already mentioned in the previous correspondence on the subject, Narendra Babu possesses mechanical ability of a very high order and has rendered valuable services to the Physics Laboratory by designing and constructing many new and delicate instruments for research as well as for demonstration purposes. He is a very successful teacher in the junior practical classes and officiated with credit in the Subordinate Educational Service for a considerable time. It was unfortunate that when the staff was re-organised in 1926, his scale of pay was reduced, but the time has come when reparation should be done to him.

I have no hesitation in recommending strongly the appointment of Babu Narendranath Sen of this department to the vacancy in the Upper S.E.S. (150-10-300-400-450) caused by the promotion of Babu Manindranath Mitra. Narendra Babu possesses mechanical ability of a very high order, and has rendered most valuable services to the Physics Laboratory by constructing many new and intricate instruments and accessories for both research and demonstration purposes. In fact much of the advanced experimental work done in this laboratory during the last 22 or 23 years beginning from the time of Sir J. C. Bose would scarcely have been possible without his help. He is also a most successful teacher in the junior practical classes. He is held in high esteem by the students as well as by the members of the teaching staff for his upright character, dignified behaviour, and pleasant manners. He had officiated with credit in the upper S. E. S. for some considerable time, and it is my considered opinion that grave injustice was done to him in not confirming him to this cadre at the time of the staff reorganization in 1926. I have always regretted the fact that I was out of India on furlough at that time, and was thus unable to press this point.

Your letter of May 30, 1934, regarding the promotion of Babu Narendra Nath Sen, Laboratory Assistant in Physics, Presidency College.

I talked the matter over with Mr. Bottomley who appreciates Naren Babu's work and is willing to promote him to a Demonstratorship, but he considers that Naren Babu should stay with you at the Presidency College for the present as he should not be transferred on promotion to a smaller college. There seems very little chance at present of raising the status of the post held by Naren Babu. Mr. Bottomley however says that when a Demonstratorship falls vacant in the Physics Department of the Presidency college you may recommend Naren Babu for promotion.
