Sir,

I have the honor to report that in consequence of a great accession in the number of students, it has become very inconvenient to hold the Particullars in the room which it now occupies, since the classes have now so full that they require a larger and more comfortable space than the rooms can spare. The last classes especially contain so great a number of boys that the place which they occupy is hardly sufficient to afford them comfortable seats. The crowded state of the school, therefore, tends, I am afraid, to bring on sickness among the students. The play ground also is so very small and narrow that it scarcely affords place for boys to have their exercises. Under these circumstances, I beg you will be pleased to

for removing the Paintshalls to its former
place.
