Sir,

With reference to office No 343 dated the 6<sup>th</sup> February, 1934 from the Physical Director, Bengal on the subject of deputation of Gymnastic Masters and Drill Masters for a course of training at the Government Training Centre in Physical Education, I have the honour to submit that Babu Gurupada Ghatak, Drill Master of this school has been doing his work with ability. He also teaches certain class subjects in the lower forms and organises games and sports for the school. But as he does not possess high academic qualification, it will not be possible for him to go through the regular theoretical training of students, which presupposes a high educational standard. Again, as he has grown somewhat bulky, the practical part of the training designed for youngmen may not suit

sent him. But as he is quite intelligent and  
can speak English fluently, I recommend that  
special steps may be taken to put him through  
a short-modified course, both practical and theoretical,  
which, I believe, will make him more efficient  
for the rest of his service.
