

He also takes part in teaching in some of the lower forms of the school. Though he speaks English fluently enough, he does not possess ~~was~~ sufficiently high academic qualifications to enable him to take the regular training mentioned in your letter. As he is moreover rather stout, he will not be probably in a position to take the practical course which, I understand, requires high standard of physical fitness. I can only recommend that he may be given a short modified course, both practical and theoretical, which might be suitable to his capacity.
