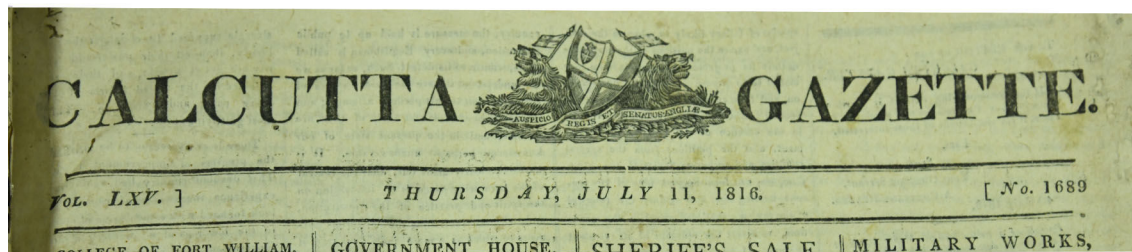


Third Meeting of Hindoo College Sub-Committee
