I have the honour to invite reference to General Department, letter No. 2645, dated the 29th June 1915 in which government accepted the resignation tendered by Babu Hriday Chandra Banerjee of his appointment as Superintendent of the Eden Hindu Hostel and sanctioned the appointment of Babu Nibaran Chandra Bhattercharjee, a Professor of the Presidency College as Superintendent of that Hostel on an allowance of Rs. 100/- per mensem in addition to his own duties with effect from the 5th July 1915.

2. I have now at the instance of the Principal, Presidency College, to point out that the allowance, sanctioned for the Superintendent, is Rs. 125/- a month and not Rs. 100/- as stated ~~xxx~~ in your letter. I, therefore, request that Government may be pleased to issue revised orders on the subject as early as practicable.

*The appointment of Babu  
Friday Chandra Banerji as Supdt. of

allowance of Rs 100/- p. m. was sanctioned  
in Secy. of State's Despatch no 85 (Public)  
dt the 29.6.06. It does not appear from  
the papers put up that the pay of the  
post was subsequently increased to Rs 125/-  
Possibly the Eden Hindu Hostel Supdt  
is drawing Rs 125/- according to the  
scale of remuneration sanctioned by  
India for College hostel Supdt. If*

If this is so, we cannot perhaps  
 sanction a fixed allowance of Rs  
 125/- for the Eden Hindu Hostel Expts.  
 as the amount of allowance may  
 vary according to the number of  
 inmates. This point was not clearly  
 stated in D.P.'s letter no 215, of the  
 3.5.15 while submitting the original  
 proposal req: the resignation of  
 Babu Friday Chandr Bengi & the  
 appointment of Pt. - Vikram Chandr  
 Shatan Chatterjee in his place. Reference  
 was rather invited to the order of  
 1906 in which an allowance  
 of Rs 100/- was sanctioned for  
 the post. In view revised order  
 we may perhaps say that Babu  
 Vikram Chandr Bhattacharyya (the present Expts)  
 will draw allowance according to  
 the scale of remuneration sanctioned  
 for the Expts of the Hostel other  
 than the College. The D.P.  
 may in the first instance be  
 asked whether this will meet  
 the case. For orders.
