

# Migration and Care-giving in Kolkata in the Age of Globalisation

MADHURILATA BASU

Two trends distinguish globalisation in contemporary times. On the one hand, we see an unprecedented flow of capital and labour and, on the other, the waning of single-site-centred manufacturing industry. The focus is now on 'assembling' industries scattered across the globe (for instance, Tata Motors in Singur was only an 'assemblage' site). In terms of labour, the emphasis is now on 'informalisation'. Even in the formal sector, employees are recruited on a 'casual'/informal basis. A significant rise in informal labour, manifested as 'new', especially 'service' related, jobs to serve the needs of 'new' or recreated urban centres/spaces, is noticeable. 'Care' is one such sector, which has grown rapidly. Be it in private nursing homes and hospitals, beauty clinics or private households, the element of care is becoming more and more important and commercially valorised.

Labour mobility consists of changes in the location of workers both across physical space (geographic mobility) and across a set of jobs (occupational mobility). With the failure of the State to deliver welfare through various schemes, the chasm between villages and cities has increased. Further, the divide between agriculture and industry, and informal and formal economies, has increased, resulting in proletarianisation.\(^1\) Though Amitabh Kundu talks of a 'decline' in migration, according to the 20th Census the total migrant population in the country is a little above 30 crore (315 million), indicating that migration has increased.\(^2\) We are also witnessing a great flow/movement/ migration of the persons involved in the 'care economy' both locally and globally.

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This chapter probes a gendered domain of labour under contemporary capitalism, namely care-giving, with a focus on ayahs and nurses in Kolkata—the nature of their jobs, pattern of mobility—on the basis of field studies in and around Kolkata in 2014, 2015 and 2016. References to domestic help and part-time domestic help, or thike, working in households have also been domestic help, or thike, working in households have also been domestic help, or thike, working in households have also been conducted in various placement centres in Kolkata. Informal interviews were also conducted in some private hospitals and nursing homes in Kolkata. Informal interviews in government hospitals have provided important insights. This chapter looks at 'care' as operating through both formal and informal structures. Nurses, working in hospitals and nursing homes, form a part of the institutional or formal care system, while the ayahs, mostly working in private households, are part of the informal care system. Though there are centres offering the services of 'trained' nurses, that aspect will not be dealt with in detail in this chapter. It is also worth mentioning here that even within a formal or institutional setup there is a formal-informal divide.

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Migration and Care-giving in Kolkata

It is also pertinent to highlight the fact that nurses, who are inextricably related to 'care' activity by dint of their knowledge, skills, experience and status, constitute the mainstream of the sector. Ayahs, on the other hand, get relegated to the margins because they lack the requisite skills, education and training. In the latter case, they are both the insider and the outsider—the fact that they are women and that the general perception is that women are natural care-givers make them insiders to the idea of care, but in the arena of care-giving as a part of Western medical hegemony, they remain outsiders.

#### INFORMAL LABOUR AND WOMEN

The informal sector, characterised by 'mobile' labour, various kinds of mobile exchange and production, a 'grey' area not taxed or regulated by the State, has grown in size since the advent of a deregulated, globalised economy. Needless to say, women are not in a favourable position in the labour market since patriarchal ideologies influence general perceptions of women as workers and patriarchal culture and norms relegate women to a secondary status in the family and society. Since women are

- Title of Table 1 not reflects its <u>content</u> and the unit of measurement is also missing. It would be better if you rename the title as " Percentage Share of <u>Apenic</u> Children and Adults in India, 2015-16 and 2019-21.
- Subsection 5.2 requires a title to maintain parity.
