WITH reference to your letter No. 5406, dated the 13th ultimo, and previous correspondence on the subject, I am directed to inform you that the Lieutenant-Governor is pleased to direct that educational officers in Bengal shall henceforth pass by the ordinary higher standard prescribed for military officers, and not by the present educational test.

2. His Honor is, however, pleased to allow officers now in the service the option of passing either by the old standard or by that now laid down.

3. I am to request that you will be so good as to communicate these orders to those officers now in the Education Department who have not yet passed in the vernacular.

With reference to your letter No. 3105, dated the 13th ultimo, and previous correspondence on the subject, I am directed to inform you that the Government is pleased to direct that all persons who have passed the ordinary examination for the post of Assistant Masters in the present educational year, and who are not yet appointed to any office, shall be allowed to continue in the service of the Government on the same terms as those who have been appointed to the office of Assistant Master, but that the old standard of pay shall not be maintained.
