With reference to your letter No. 5406, dated the 13th ultimo, and previous correspondence on the subject, I am directed to inform you that the Lieutenant-Governor is pleased to direct that educational officers in Bengal shall henceforth pass by the ordinary higher standard prescribed for military officers, and not by the present educational test.

- 2. His Honor is, however, pleased to allow officers now in the service the option of passing either by the old standard or by that now laid down.
- 3. I am to request that you will be so good as to communicate these orders to those officers now in the Education Department who have not yet passed in the vernacular.
