My dear Stapleton,

Your letter of the 20th September. I am afraid you will find Mohenjodaro further from Bombay than you seem to think it is. If you do decide to go there, the best way is to go on by boat to Karachi, take train there to Dokri and then tonga to Mohenjodaro. Mr. Mackay is now running the excavations there and it would be as well to telegraph to him beforehand. There are no Dak Bungalows there, and you would be dependent upon his hospitality and I know that he has already got several visitors (including His Excellency the Viceroy) at the end of this month.
