Sir, I have the honor to acknowledge

Constitution of the G. B.

As three years will be elapsed since the  
\*Hlog A. academic session of 1929-30, it is necessary  
to write to D. D. G. suggesting the constitution  
for the coming 3 years in the case of the members  
other than the representatives of the staff and  
for one year in the case of the representatives.

In the latter case, if M. has no objection,  
the usual procedure of getting the names of mem-  
bers by election may be adopted.

As regards the list of outside members, a  
statement is submitted for favour of M.'s inspection.

It appears that Sir N. N. Sarkar has not attended  
a single meeting.

Rai A. C. Bawari Bahadur attended ~~not~~ attended  
only two meetings at the beginning but remained  
absent at all other meetings.

The Muhammadan members have attended practi-  
cally all the meetings. But Shams-ud-ulema  
Dr. Hedayat Hossain expressed his desire to be in-  
cluded in the constitution of the G. B. of this  
college.
