READ—

Office Memorandum from the Public Works Department, No. 281AB of the 24th ultimo, and its enclosures, regarding the method of recovering from officers in the civil department the rent of public buildings occupied by them.

RESOLUTION.—When a public officer in civil employ rents a Government building, the officer in charge of the building may inform the Accountant-General in whose circle the officer who rents the building is employed, of the amount of rent payable on account of it, and the Accountant-General should make arrangements for deducting the rents from the officer's salary. If, when the officer leaves his station, any rent is still due from him, the fact should be stated in his last pay certificate, so that it may subsequently be recovered.

ORDER.—Ordered that the foregoing resolution be published in the *Gazette of India* and communicated to the Public Works and other Departments of the Government of India, the Local Governments, the Comptroller-General, the Director-General of the Post Office of India, the Mint Master, Calcutta, the Head Commissioner of Paper Currency, the Accountants-General, and the Deputy Accountants-General in independent charge.
